Profile of

TAMALE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY (TaTU)

Brief History

Tamale Technical University began as a Trades Training Centre (TTC) in 1951 and later became the Government Training School in 1954, and in 1960 it was converted to a Junior Technical Institute. As part of the Educational Reform Programme, coupled with the enactment of the PNDC Law 321 in 1992, the status of the institution was raised to the level of a Polytechnic together with Accra, Kumasi, Ho, Cape Coast and Takoradi Polytechnics on August 23, 1992.

With the passing of the Technical University Act in 2014 by the Parliament of Ghana and assented by the President, the institution after satisfying the requirements specified in the act was upgraded to a Technical University in 2018. The University now trains students up to Bachelor of Technology level with the provisions to mount post graduate degree programmes in future.

Since the inception of the University as a Trades Training Centre, its catchments area has been mainly the three traditional regions of the north, that is, Northern, Upper East and Upper West. In spite of the fact that there are now tertiary institutions in every region across the country, the student population of the University still has a reasonable representation of the traditional three regions and even beyond. This is an indication that the University continues to maintain a long-standing role as the premier training institution for middle and high levels technical and managerial personnel for the three regions of the north.

Location & Landmass

Tamale Technical University is located in the newly created Sagnarigu Municipality of the Northern Region. The Municipality was carved out from Tamale Metropolis. The school is about 3 kilometers away from the Tamale central business district. The institution shares boundary with two major educational institutions and two local communities. The institutions are Tamale Senior High School to the South-West and Bagabaga College of Education to the North-West. The communities are Wurishe community which is situated to the

North and Choggu community to the East. The University occupies a total landmass of 715,064.4 metre square.

Vision

The vision of TaTU is to become an internationally reputable institution of excellence in the provision of technical education.

Mission

The mandate of TaTU is to provide higher education and undertake research in engineering, technical and vocational based disciplines, using practical and competency-based approach that would produce professionals for industry.

Core Values

The core values of TaTU are:

- Discipline: The ability to control one's work behaviour and attitudes for improved performance.
- Efficiency: The quality of doing one's work well with minimum time and resources provided.
- Effectiveness: To conduct one's self in a way that produces the intended result and
- Excellence: We shall aim at attaining professionalism, creativity and continual improvement in every endeavour.






